

STHLNY STATUS UPDATE

Building Up Steam

Since HEAL 5 funding arrived last month, we are making steady progress on all fronts. In mid-May we hosted an operational kickoff meeting where HEAL 5 stakeholders met to review our current and planned project work and to discuss forming workgroups to address critical next step issues, such as patient consent. Our initial focus this quarter is to strengthen our existing health information exchange infrastructure so that it will support the expanding data from

additional participating doctors and hospitals. On the tech side, our team is working with Lourdes and United Health Services to introduce an Enterprise Master Person Index (EMPI). This software will establish a unique primary record for each patient in the health information exchange which contains correct data even when the information is coming from many different points of care. We are pleased to be working with Initiate Systems, an industry leader in the field, as we bring Lourdes and United Health Services on board with this important new technology.

HEAL 1 Testing Running Smoothly

Now in its third year, HEAL 1 project work is in the final testing phase with excellent results. Planning for the process and policies governing acquiring patient consent is well underway. We continue to achieve our milestones and several projects are scheduled to be completed by the Fall of this year.
